WHY ELISHA

To intentionally identify, train & nurture successive generations of Catholic Leaders.

Support Parishes in training and integrating emerging leaders through Parish Mentors.
It takes a village!

AT ONE GLANCE

ELISHA comprises a series of 5 courses + 1 stay-in retreat held in the first half of 2025.

Course fee of \$530/- per pax for the bundle of 5 courses and \$320/- per pax for the 2D1N stay-in retreat (both inclusive of GST)

Mentors for emerging leaders and new leaders are encouraged to attend the courses and retreat. A Mentor course will prepare them for mentoring (additional \$80/- per pax, inclusive of GST).



AT THE FEET OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

At the Feet of the Good Shepherd (FGS)

Self-Leadership

Through the sacrament of confession, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, inner healing prayer and 1-to-1 spiritual direction, leaders will enter into a sacred space & time of healing & restoration.

(A 2D1N stay-in Inner Healing Retreat)



Lead Like Jesus (LLJ)

Self-Leadership

A foundational module (2 sessions) based on the style of servant leadership modelled by Jesus Christ. In this module, we will explore the 4 domains (heart, head, hands, habits) of leading like Jesus.

(2 Sats, 9am - 5pm)



Building Trust (TRU)

Relational-Leadership

Participants will develop a shared understanding of the components of trust and learn how to facilitate group agreements in their community, fostering deeper levels of trust at an inter-personal and group level.

(1 Sat, 9am - 3pm)



Called & Gifted (C&G)

Self-Leadership

An intro workshop to understand our different roles and charisms in the life and service of the Church, the 24 common charisms and how to discern and use our charisms in our lives, in the life of others, our parish and the world.

(1 Sat, 9am - 4pm)



Heart-to-Heart Convos (H2H)

Relational-Leadership

A sacred time and safe space set aside to experience non-judgmental listening to ourselves and to one another in authentic heart-to-heart conversations. Listening is the foundation of mentoring, facilitating and discerning.

(1 Sat for the intro session, 9am - 3pm, followed by 3 short sessions in small groups in the parish)



Facilitating Participative Meetings (FPM)

Organisational-Leadership

Learn key tools to facilitate group discussions and meetings which are focused, Spirit-led and participative, creating a safe space for group members to contribute their gifts in a process that allows members to journey together as a group.
